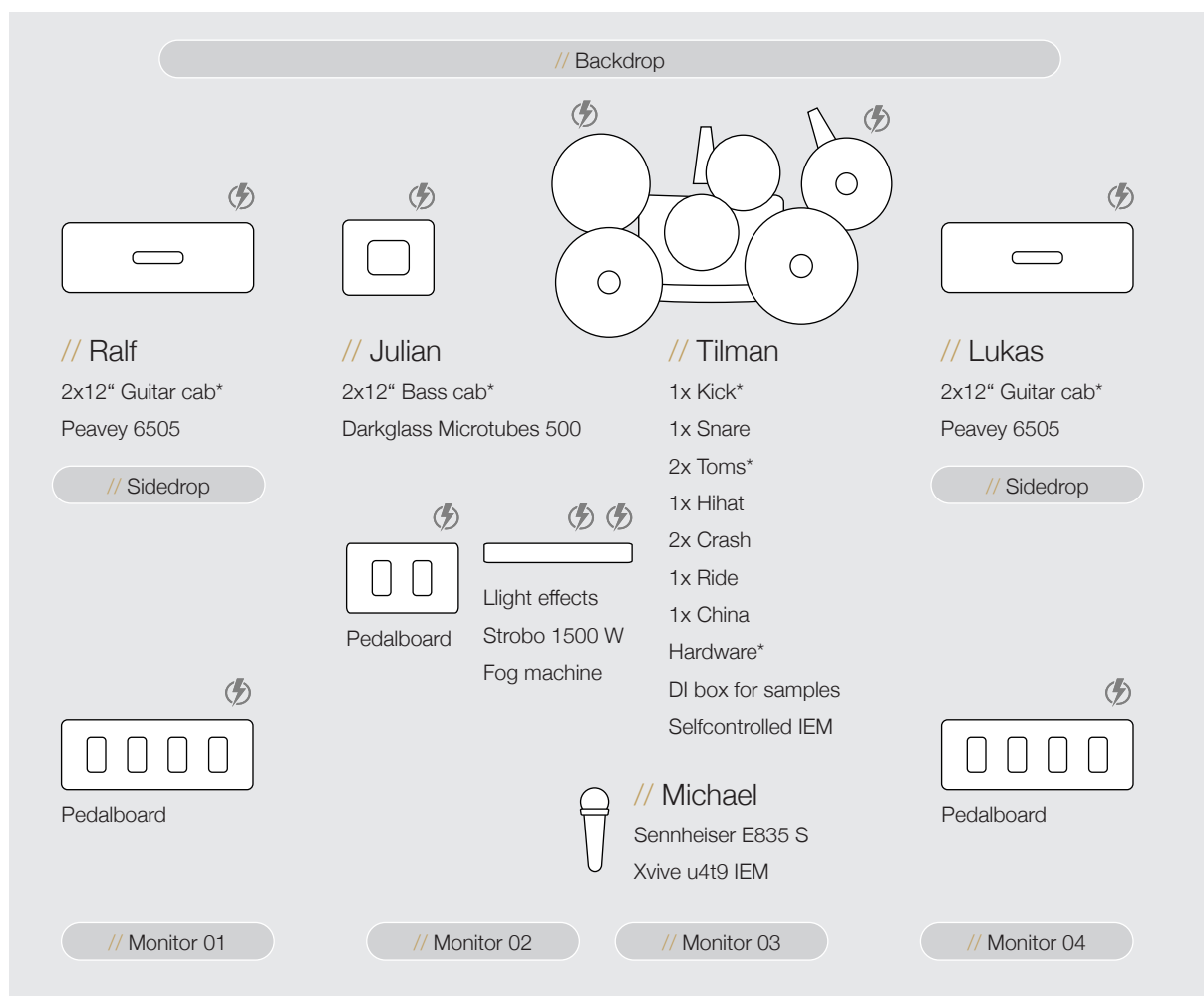
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## STAGEPLOT

Usually the venue has to offer an sound engineer who is capable of operating the local PA-system. All of the PA has to be provided by the venue. Please notice that our samples (DI box) are used throughout the show. Please never turn down the volume of the sample channel. When the circumstances requires it this stageplot can also be mirrored. Thank you!



\* this is required – regarding cabs: 2x12 are the minimum requirement ⚡ power is necessary

## MONITORING

Make sure to level up the samples on all wedges as loud as possible. We don't need monitor sound for the drums. We have a three channel mixer for our drum IEM. Please make shure to turn the drum monitor off, if there is one.

## LIGHT, FOG & VISUAL IMPRESSION

### // Light

All lights have to be turned to blue. We will bring our own strobo effect which will be controlled by us. Please focus on lights from the back – all lights in the event room, if possible at the bar and all lights which beam towards the stage have to be turned out unless otherwise discussed. Moreover be careful with the usage of moving lights – the overall impression should fit our performance and music. Thank you.

### // Fog

Normally we'll bring our own fog machine which is also controlled by ourselves. If we have no fog machine with us or the venue has better fitting one: don't hesitate to use it a lot. Thank you.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

### // Crew

Usually we travel just as a band and the venue has to offer a sound and a light engineer. Nevertheless we should be able to bring a crew of maximum 8 persons (5 bandmembers, 3 crew).

### // Backstage, Parking & Overnight stay

Due to our long ways on the road, we need a backstage to rest before and after the show (there should be free WiFi and enough multiple plugs for us). In addition to that, the venue should have a safe place to put our equipment in and a parking space for our van in front of the venue. Unless otherwise discussed we always need a reasonable place to sleep for the night.

### // Catering

Please make sure to provide a warm meal for the whole crew before and after the show. There are 3 vegetarians in our crew. There should be enough water at the stage and also beer, softdrinks, water and 2 bottles of secco in the backstage-/dressing room. If you can't provide a warm meal, you can also do a buy out of 15,00 EUR for each person of our crew.

### // Soundcheck & Line-check

The changeover should take at least 20 minutes, so we can be save to do a quick line check before the show.

### // Equipment

Our equipment will not be rented to other bands without the permission of any of us.

### // Merchandise

The venue has to offer a place to sell merchandise including a table of 2m and good lighting conditions. As long as we sell the merch by our own we won't pay any merch fees to the promoter.

### // Payment

The arranged amount of fee has to be paid directly after the show (cash payment only!). We don't accept bank transfer.



## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

### // Photo- and Videorecordings

The band permits photo and video recordings by the promoter, by press photo-/videographers tolerated by the promoter or commissioned by the band throughout the whole concert.

In any case, we ask for an accreditation list of all photographers and videographers who wish to accompany our performance one week before the start of the event so that we can check them in advance. Amateur recordings of spectators are excluded from the prior consent requirement and may be saved and published online for private use.

### // Exclusion condition

Should we discover discrimination, sexism and/or racism as well as violence against us, our crew or riots within the audience during our stay on the concert grounds before or during our show, or should we feel that our safety is at risk, we reserve the right not to perform. In this case, we request compensation in the amount of the agreed fee.
